Need

- 5G technology is a new technology with global interest, which enables entirely new types of services, applications and user experiences. It is part of a megatrend in which work, services and learning is carried out/managed/achieved remotely. The covid pandemic has further accelerated the transition to fifth-generation network technology.
- 5G technology has been proven to improve, for example, the productivity of a production plant by 30 percent.
- Many educational institutes and companies are interested in initiating 5G technology pilots and learning, as well as the utilisation of the technology in their services and operations, but the threshold seems too high and susceptible to risk.

The technology industries in Finland will need 130 000 new professionals in 10 years.

Technology studies were the <u>least</u> applied field of studies overall per study place in Finnish universities.
