According to the Legatum Prosperity Index, Finland ranks second out of 167 countries in education. The global index measures access to education, quality of education and human capital.

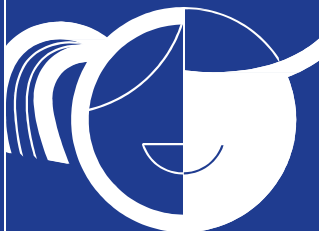
